## Official Statement

MHEREAS, the justice system of the State of Connecticut and the United States is founded on the principles of truth, fairness, and the presumption of innocence until proven guilty; and

MHEREAS, false accusations can result in severe and lasting harm, including emotional trauma, reputational damage, financial loss, and wrongful incarceration; and

MHEREAS, such accusations undermine the integrity of the legal system and erode public trust, while also harming the credibility of future legitimate claims; and

MEREAS, national surveys indicate that a significant portion of Americans have either experienced or know someone who has experienced a false accusation, underscoring the need for public awareness and legal safeguards; and

MHEREAS, International Falsely Accused Awareness Day serves to recognize the importance of due process, strengthen protection for the wrongly accused, and promote justice for all; now

THEREFORE, I, Ned Lamont, Governor of the State of Connecticut, do hereby officially proclaim September 9, 2025, as

in the State of Connecticut and urge all citizens to reflect on the importance of fairness, truth, and justice in our legal system.
